Community funding up for grabs

The Stronger Communities programme (SCP) provided assistance to 28 different community groups in Mackay, the Whitsundays, Bowen, the Burdekin and Southern Townsville in the past two years. The good news is Round 3 of this popular programme is about to commence.

This funding stream provides assistance for not-for-profit groups to undertake capital projects and grants to cover 50 per cent of their project, and between \$2500 and \$20,000 is available for up to 20 organisations.

Applications for Round 3 of the program will be accepted from August 7 and close late in September, and interested groups can find out more at www.business.gov.au/assistance/stronger-communities-programme or call my office on 4944 0662 and ask for an Expression of Interest form.

Local company wins contract

I'm pleased as punch local company Roebuck Civil has scored the contract to relocate water mains on the construction site of the new Mackay Ring Road.

This is the second local business awarded a water relocation contract on the Ring Road Project after Vassallo Construction won a contract in May. The almost-\$500 million project is a major investment in our region's road network.

The Mackay Ring Road project was identified as a priority project under the Australian Government commitment to improving the Bruce Highway, and we want local businesses to benefit from that commitment. Construction of the Mackay Ring Road is expected to be completed in mid-2020.

The Mackay Ring Road Stage 1 project is being funded with the Australian Government contributing up to \$397.9 million and the Queensland Government \$99.4 million.

Investing in regional doctors

We're attracting student doctors to our region with the establishment of the North Queensland Regional Training Hub.

The hub will provide medical students the ability to study, work and live in Mackay and Townsville. Significant progress has been made in establishing the hubs, with James Cook University focusing on a 'grow your own' model to facilitate regionally-based vocational training and career paths.

James Cook University has signed on to the project and is meeting with local health and medical providers about the new program. The hubs in Mackay and Townsville will work with healthcare providers, specialist colleges and local health authorities to develop training pathways for our future doctors in the region, improving access to medical services for regional and remote communities. Each hub, including the Regional Training Hubs at James Cook University, will receive initial funding of about \$1 million to the end of 2018.



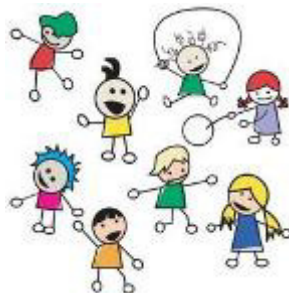
