In recent months there have been a couple of reported fuel thefts from vehicles in the area. One reported incident occurred whereby an offender has stolen about 150 litres of diesel fuel from Mackay Regional Council owned machinery. This machinery was being used to complete the much awaited upgrade of the Cape Hillsborough Road.

Locals have been waiting patiently for many years for this work to commence and it's a real shame that this occurred and subsequently delayed works. Mackay Regional Council is now looking to install trail cameras on their equipment in hope that these offences don't continue to target the vehicles.

Please, take this as a reminder that property offenders frequent the area and also live in the area, so let's be vigilant, secure and lock your valuables. Any information in relation to offences being committed in the area can be provided to Crime Stoppers on 1800 333 000.

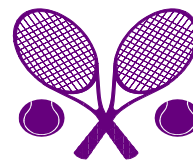

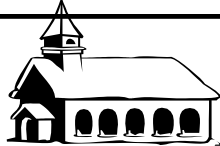

**Cane farmers reap benefits of trade deal**

Our Mackay and Whitsundays cane farmers will sell to more countries at reduced tariffs when the Comprehensive and Progressive Agreement for Trans-Pacific Partnership (CPTPP) comes into effect. The deal will give local farmers new and improved access to markets in ten countries around the Pacific Rim. I expect we will see better prices flow directly to our farmers as their products become more competitive in Japan, Canada, Mexico, Vietnam and Malaysia. The trade deal means the elimination of Japan's tariffs on

sugar exports, and the elimination of Canadian tariffs on refined sugar within five years. There will be preferential tariffs for raw sugar into Mexico, and the elimination of in-quota tariffs in Vietnam. We will also have increased access to Malaysia's food and beverage market. The CPTPP is the latest trade agreement the Coalition Government has secured, along with bilateral deals with China, Japan, South Korea and Chile, which have the potential to help agriculture grow in Mackay and the Whitsundays. Trade ministers in participating countries are expected to sign the CPTPP on March 8.

**It's a 'doggone' deal**

One of the reasons I was pushing so hard to get construction on the Mackay Ring Road started was so it could create and sustain jobs in our region. So it's great to see a local business like Dog Gone Fencing winning a contract to supply and install 12km of fencing for the \$497.3 million Mackay Ring Road project. Jack and Brenda McLean have done a fantastic job growing their business over the past decade to employ more than a dozen local people. This contract means more local jobs and dollars flowing into local bank accounts.

**Spotlight on our oldest cricket grounds**

We've lit up Harrup Park Premier Oval in Mackay to enable the hosting of national and international sporting events. The extensive lighting upgrade to one of Australia's oldest cricket grounds saw an investment of \$497,026 by the Coalition Government, as well as a chipping in of \$250,000 each by Mackay Regional Council and Mackay Cricket Association Inc. At least 50 additional lights were installed to the oval's four light towers in order to meet the brightness standards required for competitive matches. Harrup Park Country Club will celebrate its 150<sup>th</sup> anniversary this year.
